NEXT MEETING MONDAY DECEMBER 16<sup>TH</sup>, 2024 @ 7PM

The meeting of the Douglass Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:07P.M. Attending were Chairman Joshua Stouch, Vice-Chair Sara Carpenter, Supervisor Don Bergstresser, Solicitor Wendy McKenna, Manager Andrew Duncan, Khal Hassan of Pennoni & Associates, Chief Evans, Mike Heydt, and approximately 4 residents/developers. A reporter was present.

Mr. Stouch led in the Pledge of Allegiance and announced that there was an Executive Session held this evening from approximately 6:30pm to 6:45pm involving personnel matters. No decisions or votes were taken.

Mr. Stouch asked if there were any additions, corrections, or comments to the minutes of the November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Board of Supervisors Meeting, none were given.

Oak Mill Escrow Reduction Request #4 (\$36,611.77) - an escrow release request has been received from Chatham Creek, LLC for Oak Mill escrow release #4 in the amount of \$36,611.77. Mr. Hassan said a site inspection was conducted November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024 and based on our observations of the work, we recommend the requested release.

A motion was made by Mr. Stouch, seconded by Ms. Carpenter to approve the Oak Mill escrow release #4, based on the recommendation of the Township Engineer, in the amount of \$36,611.77 with \$63,395.38 remaining in escrow.
