## HOW TO PLANT A TREE!



PROPER PLANTING WILL HELP YOUR TREES NOT JUST SURVIVE, BUT THRIVE!

Proper Tree Planting Step by Step:

- Dig a hole twice the width and the same depth of the tree's root ball.
- Ensure the bottom of the whole is level and firm.
- Remove the tree from the container by gently pressing the sides of the container.
- Loosen the root ball, allowing roots to spread and to remove circling roots.
- ✓ Locate the root flare by brushing away soil from around the trunk until the the first roots growing from the trunk are visible.
- Place the root ball in the hole and ensure the root flare is level with the ground surface. Adjust your hole as needed.
- Making sure your tree is standing straight, begin to backfill with native soil. Do not put large rocks or vegetation in your planting backfill.
- Gently pack backfilled soil around the root ball. Ensure soil is packed enough so that your tree can stand on its own, but do not compact the soil.
- ✓ Water your tree until it is established.
- ✓ Prune dead, damaged, or diseased branches.
- Properly mulch your tree, ensuring mulch does not touch or pile up on the trunk.
