MEETING MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING – Board of Supervisors
February 26, 2026 – 6:30pm

The Special Meeting of the Douglass Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 6:31pm. Attending were Chairman Joshua Stouch, Vice Chairman Don Bergstresser, Solicitor Blake Dunbar, and Interim Manager David Thompson. Supervisor Sara Carpenter was absent. Also in attendance were YMCA representatives John Derham and Jennifer Segelken, and residents Ed Reitz and Michael Heydt.

Mr. Stouch led in the Pledge of Allegiance and read the Public Meeting Policy Announcement.

MontCo 2040 Grant Application – YMCA Playground – Resolution #02232026-01

Mr. Stouch requested an update on the YMCA's Montco 2040 grant application for a new playground proposal at their early learning facility (144 Holly Rd). Solicitor Blake Dunbar presented an updated Resolution #02232026-01 and the details of a Cooperation Agreement that were prepared by his office. The Board had no issues with the documents, and a copy of the agreement was provided to YMCA representatives John Derham and Jennifer Segelken with instructions to review with their legal representatives. Interim Manager David Thompson stated the YMCA submitted all the necessary paperwork and escrow to satisfy the professional services agreement except for the W-9 that will not be an issue obtaining.

Mr. Stouch raised concerns about adequate parking spaces and safety considerations for spaces near the playground. Mr. Derham stated that the playground will be surrounded by bollards and comply with all the necessary safety requirements. He also stated they will need to evaluate the parking spaces, relocating spaces if needed. He stated they must comply with 1 space for every 15 students plus 1 space for every worker. Mr. Stouch requested confirmation the park would be open to the public. Mr. Derham confirmed the park would be open to the public during non-operating hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays.

Motion: Mr. Stouch made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bergstresser to authorize Resolution 02232026-01 supporting the YMCA's MontCo 2040 Implementation Grant application. Bergstresser – Aye, Stouch – Aye. Motion passed.

Mr. Stouch and Mr. Bergstresser signed three copies of the resolution and presented one to the YMCA representatives.

There was no Public Comment, Old or New Business.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:40pm.
