Guidelines for Solicitation and Peddlers Applications

- A permit must be obtained prior to soliciting and/or peddling goods.
- A permit can be issued up to a thirty (30) day period and at the end of thirty (30) days from the date of issue, the permit must be re-issued and an additional fee paid. Fee is \$100.00/person per day for the first five (5) days, then \$20.00/day per person after.
- Each individual will receive a license which must be visible to all police officers, Township officials, and citizens.
- Hours of solicitation/peddling: 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM Monday – Saturday, no Sundays.
- Wares and Goods can only be sold as listed on the permit application and license.
- Any applicant that has outstanding fines or citations that results in a warrant of arrest being issued in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will result in immediate denial.
- Any warnings or solicitation license suspensions within the past 12 months in Douglass Township or other agencies in Montgomery County will result in denial of application.

Application for Solicitation and Peddling

- A completed application by each person involved in soliciting and/or peddling
- Copies of all vehicle(s) registration and insurance cards
- Photo identification – except minors under 16 years of age. Acceptable photo identification would include the following: drivers license, state identification card, passport, student identification card, etc...
- If applicable, proper paperwork documenting that the minor is eligible for employment
- A Criminal History Check by the Pennsylvania State Police and the state of residency (out-of-state) within the past thirty (30) days
